Information about the town and/or neighborhood	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The EOI is located in Seville, in the Macarena neighborhood. The area occupied by the Macarena neighborhood is one of the most populated in Seville, especially when referring to the Municipal District. It covers a large part of the North Zone, from the banks of the Guadalquivir, which has continued to grow to include the municipal area up to the Hospital de San Lazaro and the Cemetery of San Fernando. The current Arco, next to the Basilica of the Brotherhood of La Macarena, was one of the gateways into the city, on the outskirts of which was the Hospital de las Cinco Llagas or de la Sangre, now the Parliament of Andalusia, as well as plenty of land for planting. These gardens were a large part of the livelihood of the population. The EOI is quite close to the center of the city, where one can find a wide range of leisure activities: bars, squares such as La Alameda, cinemas, theater,

You can eat arepas at Carayaca, swim in the pool at the Forus gym, see puppets at the Alameda Theater, or just walk along the river, even reaching the Alamillo Park and all its charms.
